**Rubin and Marie Logan Scholarship Fund**

**Purpose and Guidelines**

**Eligibility**

Scholarship grants are to be given to active members of the Woodbury Seventh-day Adventist Church or to their dependents.

A limit of two scholarships per church family (from the same household) per school year. Exception can be made based on available funds.

Scholarships are available to members attending a state college or technical school or an SDA accredited academy or college or home study program. Requesting college student must be currently enrolled full time (12 or more hours) in B.S., B.A. or associate degree program or a technical program of study.

All students must maintain a grade average of C or above to qualify for future assistance.

**Distribution**

Scholarships are based on investment income and the amounts will vary from year to year. Distribution will be made at the beginning of the school year for academy students and twice a year for college level students.

**Guidelines**

The committee has established guidelines for book and computer purchases as follows:

- Scholarship funds are to be used only for books or computers. Book scholarships for academy students will be paid directly to the school at the beginning of the school year. Book scholarships for college students will be divided for fall and spring semesters.
- A one time scholarship of \$600 for an entry level laptop or desktop computer, receipt for purchase required. A request for printers will not be considered from this scholarship fund. The scholarship recipient is responsible for the maintenance and safekeeping of their computer. Scholarships to replace lost, stolen or damaged computers will not be considered.
- Students applying for the laptop computer scholarship will not be eligible for the book scholarship in the same school year period.

**Process of application**

- The student must submit an application complete with attachments and exhibit a financial need.
- A statement of educational goal and time frame to reach that goal.
- Attachments include (1) proof of registration, (2) grade report from last semester, (3) receipts if requesting computer scholarship, receipts for books if applicable.

Granting of scholarships by the Scholarship Committee is not automatic. Each year the applicant must make a request for scholarship consideration and to show proof of need and maintenance of the required grade level mentioned in above. Scholarships at the college level will be considered for a four year period. If a course of study has not been completed in a four year period, consideration will be given applicants for one additional year to complete technical course of study, but only after any new first year applications are given a priority review.
